The Creative Arts Academy of the Quad Cities is designed to meet the individual artistic and academic needs of the students accepted into its program. Since the support of the program is essential, it is necessary for parents and students to understand and agree to the following:

- Students are expected to attend school daily, arrive promptly, and remain throughout the scheduled school hours.
- Students are to conduct themselves with teachers, classmates, artists, mentors, and other adults in a manner showing respect to all persons.
- Students are to complete all required work, including homework and missed work due to conflicting performances, field trips, and/or illness.
- All students must respect and care for all equipment, supplies, and school property.
- I understand that if I choose to or am asked to leave the Creative Arts Academy, I may not re-enter unless there are rare and extenuating circumstances as approved by the CAA Director, Superintendent and/or Board of Education.
- Students are expected to participate in Creative Arts Academy artistic events and rehearsals, which sometimes extend beyond the normal school hours. Creative Arts Academy artistic events and rehearsals will take priority over outside activities.
- Outside community events and rehearsals must be limited so as not to restrict school attendance or classwork.
- In most cases, items for personal use, such as most musical instruments, dance leotards and shoes, etc., shall be provided by the student.
- Students are expected to conduct themselves with the highest standards of honesty and integrity whilst attending the Creative Arts Academy.
- Creative Arts Academy students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0. Failure to maintain a 2.0 or higher GPA will result in the student being placed on probation and participation in area arts performances and/or exhibits.
- Students must abide by all rules outlined in the Davenport Community Schools Board Policy 504-Discipline and Behavior and the CAA Guidelines and Procedures.
- I understand that above student's year-to-year standing at the Creative Arts Academy is not automatic. Each student will have a Status Review each spring for the following school year.
- The Creative Arts Academy administration reserves the right to terminate a student's admittance status based on on-going, documented behavioral issues, lack of effort, and/or lack of academic progress.
